

# Lesson Review Script

Print one copy for your use during the Come On In Activity. After children have colored the Lesson Review Coloring Sheets, call on them to tape them on the board as you describe briefly what occurred in the lesson. See script below.

## LESSON 1

God made many promises in the Old Testament. One special promise was that one day Jesus would come! The old man in the Temple, Simeon, knew that God promised to send a Savior to the world. Simeon trusted God. He waited and waited. Finally, Jesus was born, and Simeon got to hold Him in his arms! How exciting to see God's promise come true after waiting so long! Simeon trusted God's Word. Jesus came just like God said He would.

## LESSON 2

We learned that the New Testament is from God. It is all true. God sent the Holy Spirit to help men remember what Jesus did and said. Then the Helper, God's Holy Spirit, helped them write about Jesus—why He came, what He did, how He died, and lots more. John and other writers of the New Testament knew Jesus. They lived at the same time as Jesus. It was a long, long time ago. But we still have the Bible today, and we can still trust it to be true!

## LESSON 3

The whole Bible is about Jesus, but the Gospels are especially about Jesus's life here on earth. God's Holy Spirit helped four men—Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John—write the Gospels. The Gospels tell us the good news that Jesus is God's Son—the only one who could die and offer forgiveness for our sins. Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John wrote the Gospels so we could know about Jesus Christ.

## LESSON 4

Each Gospel tells something special about Jesus! *Matthew* wrote his Gospel to show everyone that Jesus is the King that they were all waiting for. *Mark* called Jesus the suffering servant. He wanted us to know that Jesus came to serve others and give His life so sinners can be saved. *Luke* tells us that Jesus came to seek and save the lost sinners. He came to look for the lost and save them from their sins. And *John* wanted everyone to know that Jesus is the Son of God, the Savior, and that Jesus offers eternal life to those who believe in Him!

## LESSON 5

Jesus's life was different from anyone else's—ever! Jesus—who is God—came to the earth to be born as a baby. But Jesus is God! He had a plan and a purpose. Jesus grew up and taught people about sin and told them they needed someone to save them from sin. Only Jesus could be the Savior because He never sinned. When He died on the Cross, He took the punishment for sinners. But that wasn't the end! Jesus rose from the dead! He is God, and He is all-powerful! His life was very different from anyone else's—ever!
