1. What is the attribute that means God is in control of everything? *Sovereign.*
2. What did the believers do when the persecution got bad in Jerusalem? *Many left to escape it. They moved away.*
3. What did the believers talk about even after they ran away? *Jesus. The gospel.*
4. How did God use the horrible persecution for His good? What was happening to the church? *It was growing because the believers were still preaching.*
5. Who was the missionary we talked about today? *Acts 8:4–8. Philip.*
6. What did Philip preach in Samaria? *Acts 8:5. He preached Christ/the gospel to them.*
7. God gave Philip special powers. What did the people of Samaria see Philip do? *Acts 8:6. Miracles.*
8. Did the people of Samaria reject the gospel of Jesus Christ, or did they receive it with joy? *Acts 8:8. They received it with joy!*
9. True or False. God sometimes works everything out for good for those who love Him. *Romans 8:28. False. God is in control at all times and uses ALL situations for the good of those who love Him.*
10. Who did Philip meet on the road to Gaza? *Acts 8:27. A man of Ethiopia.*
11. True or False. The man from Ethiopia was an official of the king of Ethiopia. *Acts 8:27. False. He worked for the queen of Ethiopia.*
12. What was the man from Ethiopia doing when Philip met up with him? *Acts 8:28. He was reading the Scriptures—the book of Isaiah.*
13. What did Philip do when he heard the man reading? *Acts 8:35. Philip explained the Scriptures and preached Jesus to him.*
14. What did the Ethiopian do when Philip told him about Jesus? *Acts 8:37. He believed!*
15. What did the Ethiopian want to do after hearing the truth about Jesus? *Acts 8:36. Get baptized.*
16. How did God use the persecution of the Christians for His good? *More people heard the gospel and the church grew.*
17. What did the Ethiopian man likely do when he got back to Ethiopia? *He probably told all his friends, family, and even the queen about Jesus and the gospel.*
18. Can you recite the memory verse we are working on? *Romans 1:16. For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek.*
