Print one Answer Key for your use during the game. You may want to give the Scripture references and have students look up the answers.

1. Who questioned Jesus and brought charges against Him? *Luke 22:66. The Jewish leaders: the elders, chief priests, and scribes.*
2. They asked Jesus to tell them if He was the Christ in Luke 22:67. What did they mean by "The Christ"? *The Messiah.*
3. Jesus said He was going to be seated at the right hand of God soon. Was He saying that He was the Messiah, the Son of God? Yes or No? *Yes.*
4. Is it wrong to claim to be the Son of God when you really are the Son of God? *No.*
5. Why did the Jews think Jesus should die? *John 19:7. Because He made Himself the Son of God.*
6. What kind of power did Pilate claim to have over Jesus? *John 19:10. The power to crucify Jesus and the power to let Him go; basically, power over His life or death.*
7. Jesus said Pilate's power came from somewhere else. Where did Pilate's authority come from? *John 19:11. From God.*
8. Whose plan was this? *It was always God's plan.*
9. The Jews wanted Jesus to die for blasphemy. What is blasphemy? A. Calling Himself the Son of God; B. Claiming to be God; C. Claiming to be the Messiah; D. Claiming to be the Son of God; or E. All of the Above. *Answer: E. All of the Above.*
10. Which happened first? A. Jesus was questioned by the council. B. Jesus was brought to Pilate. C. Jesus was arrested. *Answer: Jesus was arrested.*
11. Why did God plan for Jesus to be arrested and accused, to suffer and be killed? *It was the way to provide salvation from sin.*
12. Blasphemy is claiming to be God. Why wasn't Jesus guilty of the charge of blasphemy against God? *Jesus was innocent of the charge because He actually is God!*
13. In John 10:31, Jesus said, "I and the Father are one." What did the Jews do when they heard Jesus say that? *John 10:31. They picked up stones to stone and kill Him.*
14. Name one way that the Jewish leaders should have known that Jesus was the Messiah. *By His miracles and by His words—what He taught and the fact that He said He was the Messiah.*
15. When Jesus was questioned and beaten during His trials, did He ever sin? *No. Jesus is God. He never sinned.*
16. Did Jesus deserve to suffer and die? Yes or no? *No. He committed no sin.*
17. Where did Pilate's authority come from? *John 19:11. God. All authority ultimately comes from God; He is in control all the time.*
18. Was Jesus forced to go through with God's plan, or did He go willingly? *He went willingly.*
