Characters: Narrator, Servant Girl, Peter, Others, Jesus

Narrator: ⁶⁶ Now as Peter was below in the courtyard, one of the servant girls of the high priest came. ⁶⁷ And when she saw Peter warming himself, she looked at him and said,

Servant Girl: “You also were with Jesus of Nazareth.”

Narrator: ⁶⁸ But he denied it, saying,

Peter: “I neither know nor understand what you are saying.”

Narrator: And he went out on the porch, and a rooster crowed. ⁶⁹ And the servant girl saw him again, and began to say to those who stood by,

Servant Girl: “This is one of them.”

Narrator: ^{70a} But he denied it again. ^{70b} And a little later those who stood by said to Peter again,

Others: “Surely you are one of them; for you are a Galilean, and your speech shows it.”

Narrator: ⁷¹ Then he began to curse and swear,

Peter: “I do not know this Man of whom you speak!”

Narrator: ⁷² A second time the rooster crowed. Then Peter called to mind the word that Jesus had said to him,

Jesus: “Before the rooster crows twice, you will deny Me three times.”
