Print one Answer Key for your use during the game. You may want to give the Scripture references and have students look up the answers.

1. Before Jesus was killed, He was beaten and mocked. What painful object did soldiers put on Jesus's head to make fun of Him? *Matthew 27:29.*
A crown of thorns.
2. Jesus was weak and could not carry His own cross. Who was made to help Him? *Matthew 27:32*
Simon of Cyrene.
3. Why did the soldiers make Simon of Cyrene carry Jesus's Cross? *Because Jesus had been beaten so badly, He was too weak to carry it all the way.*
4. Where was Jesus crucified? *Matthew 27:33. Golgotha.*
Place of a Skull.
5. Jesus was crucified. What does it mean to crucify someone? *Their hands and feet are nailed to a cross and they are left to hang there until they die.*
6. What happened between the sixth hour and the ninth hour as Jesus died—between 12 noon and 3:00 pm? *Matthew 27:45. Darkness was over all the land.*
7. How many hours was it dark while Jesus was on the Cross? *Matthew 27:45. Three hours.*
8. At about the ninth hour Jesus cried out in a loud voice. What did He say? *Matthew 27:46. "Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani?" that is, "My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?"*
9. Before Jesus gave up His spirit and died, what did He say? *John 19:30. It is finished!*
10. Why did God send His perfect son, Jesus, to die?
So sinners could be saved.
11. Jesus bore the wrath of His Father against sin. What did His sacrifice make available to sinners?
Forgiveness of sins.
12. Why did God have to turn away from Jesus? *The sins of many were placed on Jesus.*
13. What did Jesus finish? Why did He say "It is finished" right before He died on the Cross? *(Take answers that match up the general idea of this answer.) Jesus had finished the work the Father had sent Him to do. He had been perfectly obedient in life, and He had suffered and died bearing the punishment of sin so that those who believe could have eternal life. Jesus was the perfect sacrifice for sin.*
14. Who did Christ die for on the Cross? *Romans 5:6.*
The ungodly. Sinners.
15. Who are the ungodly? *Everyone. All sin and deserve God's wrath and punishment.*
16. How did God show His love for sinners? *Romans 5:8. He showed His love that Jesus died while we were still sinners.*
17. What are sinners who believe in Jesus saved from? *Romans 5:9. God's wrath, punishment.*
18. What is God's wrath? *God's anger against sin that leads Him to punish sinners.*
