1. How did the religious leaders react to what the apostles were doing and saying? *They were angry and wanted to stop them.*
2. What were the apostles preaching about? *Jesus and the truth of the gospel.*
3. Who was angry at what Peter and John preached? *Acts 4:1. The Jewish leaders.*
4. When the Jewish leaders got upset at Peter and John's preaching, what did they do? *They put them in custody (jail). Acts 4:3.*
5. Why did the religious leaders want to stop the apostles from teaching about Jesus? *They were jealous. They didn't believe Jesus.*
6. When Peter and John were preaching about Jesus at the Temple, how many heard and believed? *Acts 4:4. 5,000.*
7. Where did Peter and John get the power to heal the lame man in the Temple? *Acts 4:8. From God, the Holy Spirit.*
8. Peter and John were teaching and healing people in whose name? *Acts 4:10. Jesus's name.*
9. When the apostles were arrested, what were they commanded to stop doing? *Tell others about Jesus.*
10. Why did the Jewish leaders threaten the apostles and tell them not to speak or teach in the name of Jesus? *They didn't want the truth of the gospel to spread or the church to grow. They were jealous.*
11. When the apostles were commanded not to speak or teach in Jesus's name, who did they say they had to listen to? *Acts 4:19–20. God, not man.*
12. After they were released from the authorities and after they were threatened, what did the apostles and their friends do? *Acts 4:24. They praised God and prayed. They rejoiced.*
13. Who gave Jesus's followers the wisdom and courage to preach Jesus's name boldly? *The Holy Spirit.*
14. The apostles were arrested. How were they hurt? What were they told? *Acts 5:40. They were beaten and commanded not to speak in the name of Jesus.*
15. Whose name were the apostles glad to suffer for? *Acts 5:41. Jesus's.*
16. What is it called when someone suffers harm because he is preaching or teaching the name of Jesus? *Persecution.*
17. What is the memory verse we are studying now? *Romans 1:16.*
18. Whose power is in the gospel of Christ according to our memory verse? *The power of God.*
