

Four in a Row Teacher Guide

Print one sheet to guide you through the activity.

INSTRUCTIONS

Use masking tape to make a 16-section square on the floor. The square should be four sections wide by four sections high. Each section should be equal in size. Cut 8 red circles and 8 black circles from the red and black construction paper. (Or use other appropriate markers for the two teams.)

Divide the students into two teams—red team and black team. Give each team eight paper circles—either red or black. Students will toss the beanbag to a square. They will answer a question. If they answer correctly, they can put a marker in that square.

To win the game, teams must get four circles in a row—achieved by answering the questions correctly.

QUESTIONS

1. Use Paul's Missionary Journeys Map to locate the city of Philippi, one of the cities Paul stopped in during his second missionary journey. *Have team locate Philippi on the map.*
2. Paul and Silas went out of the city of Philippi to the riverside. Who did they meet there? *Acts 16:13. Women who were there to pray.*
3. What was the name of the woman Paul talked to? *Acts 16:14. Lydia.*
4. Who did Paul tell the women at the river about? *Acts 16:14. Jesus.*
5. What did the Lord do for Lydia while she was listening to Paul teach about Jesus? *Acts 16:14. He opened her heart to believe the things Paul said about Jesus.*
6. Paul and Silas were in trouble in Philippi. What were they accused of? Was it A) Stealing from the Temple, B) Killing a slave, or C) troubling the city with teaching about Jesus, the Messiah? *Acts 16:20. Answer: C) troubling the city with teaching about Jesus.*
7. What was their punishment for teaching about Jesus in Philippi? *Acts 16:22. They were beaten with rods.*
8. After Paul and Silas were beaten, where were they taken? *Acts 16:24. They were put in prison.*
9. How did Paul and Silas act in prison? Did they A) Cry and fight back against the guards, B) Pray and sing hymns to God, C) try to bribe the guard. *Acts 16:25. Answer: B) Pray and sing hymns to God.*
10. Something happened in the prison that caused chaos and confusion. What was it? *Acts 16:26. There was a great earthquake.*
11. What happened to the prison doors and the prisoners' chains because of the earthquake? *Acts 16:26. They doors were opened, and everyone's chains came off.*
12. The prison guard was afraid! What was he going to do? *Acts 16:27. Kill himself.*
13. Who stopped the prison guard from killing himself? *Acts 16:28. Paul.*
14. What did the prison guard want to know? *Acts 16:30. He wanted to know how to be saved.*
15. What did Paul tell the jailer he had to do to be saved? *Acts 16:31. Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ.*
