

Four in a Row Teacher Guide

Print one sheet to guide you through the activity.

INSTRUCTIONS

Use masking tape to make a 16-section square on the floor. The square should be four sections wide by four sections high. Each section should be equal in size. Cut 8 red circles and 8 black circles from the red and black construction paper. (Or use other appropriate markers for the two teams.)

Divide the students into two teams—red team and black team. Give each team eight paper circles—either red or black. Students will toss the beanbag to a square. They will answer a question. If they answer correctly, they can put a marker in that square.

To win the game, teams must get four circles in a row—achieved by answering the questions correctly.

1. From our memory verse, name one thing that we should always do. *1 Thessalonians 5:16–18. Rejoice.*
2. Also from our memory verse, what should we do without ceasing? *1 Thessalonians 5:16–18. Pray.*
3. And again from our memory verse, what should we give thanks for? *1 Thessalonians 5:16–18. Everything.*
4. What are sinners who receive and believe in Jesus Christ now called? *John 1:12. Children of God.*
5. Finish this statement. Romans 8:14 tells us that if we are led by the Spirit of God, we are _____.
_____. *Romans 8:14. Sons of God.*
6. What are believers able to cry out, or call, to God when they receive the Spirit of adoption? *Romans 8:15. "Abba, Father."*
7. What does Abba mean? *It means dear Father—someone who loves us. We don't need to be afraid of Him.*
8. Who adopts a believer as His child when we believe and trust in Jesus? *God.*
9. If a person is a child of God, who would his Brother be? Hint: God's only begotten Son. *Jesus.*
10. How can you describe the inheritance God has promised us? *Perfect. Heaven. Incorruptible. Undefined. Unfading.*
11. Who is adopted into God's family as His children? *Those who believe, trust, receive Jesus Christ.*
12. Where is the promised, perfect inheritance reserved for the believer? *1 Peter 1:4. In heaven.*
