Paul and Mary Kamunge Christian Outreach International



Paul and Mary live in Kijabe, Kenya, Africa. They studied in the US and in 2006 were introduced to LCC. A group traveled to Kenya to visit their ministry firsthand and LCC has supported them since. They recently returned to Kenya after a 5-month sabbatical in the US. They have 3 main ministries there in Kenya.

Moffat Bible College

Paul Kamunge is President of Moffat Bible College. Both Paul and Mary teach at the college. The college offers majors in Bible and Theology, Counseling and Chaplaincy, and Community Health and Development. Students attend from all parts of Africa as well as from other countries. Most of the students return to their home to serve locally after their studies. They had 35 students graduate last July.

Sunrise Orphans

The Sunrise Ministry provides support to orphans living in the area. Most of these children live with other family members. The Kamunges visit them and help supply their needs; often building a better house for the family. They invite the kids to Sunday School and usually have a big crowd. They share the Gospel with the kids and their relatives.



Rural Church

Paul and a team lead a church in a rural area. Before leaving on their sabbatical Paul and the team were evangelizing the motorcycle transport riders who have a station right outside the church. Many came to church when invited and they hope to disciple them more.
